Competition Guide

A brief guide for running 2018 Online AMC

This guide is for competition day.

Competition date and timing

Thursday 9 August

Online AMC window: 7 am 09/8/18 to 7 pm 10/8/18 AEST

Primary: 60 minutes Secondary: 75 minutes

The AMC is a competition and should be conducted under exam conditions.

Before the competition day please ensure you have completed the **system requirements** check. Use the 'System Requirements Check' at amt.edfinity.com/help See also **Technical Information for System Administrators**.

Competition day

Supervisors need the **AMT school code**, an **activation** code to start the competition (one per sitting group), and an **administration** code to add extra time (keep secure). See complete manual for activation codes.

Students should have a copy of the **scribble** sheet for their division. Mobile phones should be stored away from the students' desks.

Student registration on competition day

1. Students go to competition site and sign up with an email address (or username) and password. If they have used GetSet AMC, they may already have an account. If forgotten, or a new user, enter new details. NB If a student has recently used GetSet and not logged out, they will need to log out before registering for the competition.

- You have **60** minutes to complete the competition.

Competition begins: give students the **activation** code to start the competition.

Supervisor may use the secure **administration** code to add time to a student's timer during the competition if a computer malfunction or other serious event occurs. This can be done by clicking on the 'Supervisor access' link on the right side of the student's screen. Keep this code private. Do not SAVE it on the student's device nor give it to a student.

Competition ends: when complete, the student should click on 'I am finished'. (The competition will close off automatically after the set time.)
