	<b>AMT High Achiever</b>	Top three male and top three female students in each state/territory. One each in years 3-12.	Certificate
	<b>AMT Champion School</b>	Australian schools that entered at least one AMT competition or program in the year. Two schools per state/territory. Awarded at the discretion of the AMT.	Plaque
	<b>AMT Teacher/Volunteer Award</b>	Teachers or volunteers who have gone above and beyond to support and inspire their school, class and students. Three nominees and one winner in each state/territory. Nominated by school Principals or Heads of Mathematics.	\$250 for top three nominees per state/territory. The winner earns an additional \$750 and a trophy.
	<b>AMT Inspiring Student Award</b>	Outstanding students who have inspired their school or class and supported their peers in the learning and enjoyment of mathematics/algorithmics. Three nominees and one winner in each state/territory. Nominated by school Principals, Heads of Mathematics or teachers.	Certificates and book vouchers for top three nominees, as well as a trophy for the winner.

	<b>High Distinction</b>	<b>AMC:</b> students in the top 3% in each state/territory, years 3-10. Students in the top 5% in each state/territory, years 11-12. <b>CAT:</b> students in the top 2% in each state/territory, years 5-12.	Certificate
	<b>Distinction</b>	<b>AMC:</b> students in the top 20% in each state/territory, years 3-10. Students in the top 25% in each state/territory, years 11-12. <b>CAT:</b> students in the top 15% in each state/territory, years 5-12.	Certificate
	<b>Best in School</b>	<b>AMC and CAT:</b> awarded to a student if both the school and student meet the pre-set criteria. Awarded in addition to a certificate of merit.	Certificate
	<b>Credit</b>	<b>AMC:</b> students in the top 55% in each state/territory, years 3-10. Students in the top 60% in each state/territory, years 11-12. <b>CAT:</b> students in the top 50% in each state/territory, years 5-12.	Certificate
	<b>Proficiency</b>	<b>AMC:</b> students who have achieved a pre-set score but have not been awarded a Credit (or higher) certificate.	Certificate
	<b>Participation</b>	<b>AMC and CAT:</b> all students who have participated but didn't obtain any other award or certificate.	Certificate
