The FARM committee's responsibilities are to:

1. Review annual Business as Usual (BAU), Strategic Project and capital budgets and make recommendations on adoption or revision to the Board
2. Review and advise the Board on the Trust's risk management processes and material business risks,
3. Work with the AMT's external auditor to consider appropriateness of financial controls and reporting,
4. Review the management of AMT investments,
5. Recommend the appointment of the external auditor to the Board; and
6. Any other duties that are delegated to it from time to time by the Board.

Potential applicants should have at least five years' experience in a senior role in the commercial, not-for-profit or education sectors and be able to demonstrate skills, interest and experience of:

- 1) Corporate financial management, analysis and budgeting,
- 2) Enterprise-wide risk management and governance,
- 3) Compliance and legislation relevant to not-for-profits,
- 4) External audit processes, and
- 5) Investment management.

The FARM Committee meets quarterly with at least two meetings face-to-face in Canberra.

The AMTT Ltd Board meets quarterly with at least three meetings face-to-face in Canberra.
